

Raphael's Adjustable Float Frame

Pricing and Ordering one of these custom Float Frames is not very difficult if you follow this step-by-step routine using the drawing in the center of the page as your reference.

The Parts You Can Choose or Change

- The species used for the Upright (showing) section of the frame
- The Inside Height (dimension A) of the Upright
- The Inside Base Width (dimension B)

The Parts That Are Predetermined

- The thickness of the Upright (1) and Base (2) sections. They are 7/16" and 3/8" respectively
- The species used to make the Base (it may be Basswood, Pine or Virola)
- All Frames are sold sanded smooth but otherwise unfinished.

STEP 1 How tall would you like us to make the Upright section on your Float Frame? Choose size Up to 2" for Maple or Lt Mahogany – up to 3" for other species:

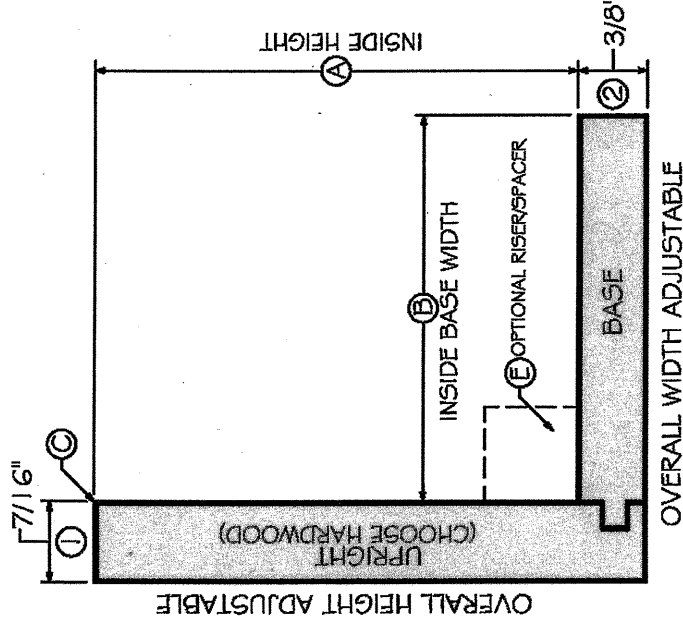
