



## THE ADJUSTABLE HARDWOOD FLOAT FRAME FROM RAPHAEL'S

### Notes about this drawing:

- The thickness of the upright portion of the frame ① and the base ② are fixed at the sizes shown
- You have a choice of three different sizes available for the Inside Base Width – 1-1/4", 1-1/2" or 1-3/4"
- The maximum overall height of the upright portion of the frame is limited to 3-1/2" in all species except Lt Mahogany and Maple where it is limited to only 2".
- In addition to offering the "spacer/riser" (shown in the drawing above as E) that is a part of the frame, we also offer a variety of rectangular shaped "Lifters" that can be attached to the bottom of almost any canvas to lift it to the desired height in any frame.
- We offer Black Priming of the inside base and inside height surfaces of our Float Frames for an additional cost of \$0.75/ft.

### Other Notes:

- "Raw" Float Frames are well sanded and ready to have a finish applied. We use only select grade hardwood stock that is free of defects when ordered as a Cut and Joined Frame. If purchased in Length there will be no more than a single defect per 5 ft section of the moulding.
- In terms of the "finishes" offered we offer only what we believe can be produced on a consistent basis. For most species a "finished frame" includes two coats of a Clear Satin Lacquer. Peruvian Walnut looks best with a Danish Oil finish. Beech and Canarywood look very nice with just two coats of wax. The Price List for this product shows the finishes available for each species and the cost.
- We sell our Adjustable Float Frames either "Cut and Joined" ready to fit around your art, or in random lengths with a minimum purchase of 20 ft. Sticks are between 5 ft and 7ft and will be evenly assorted in terms of their lengths in any purchase. This is not a production moulding, it is a very custom product. Every stick is created by hand for your order. Because the cutting and joining of "taller" Float Frame mouldings requires special skills and equipment to be done well, we do not sell these mouldings in Chop form.
